Train

Airplane

In Warsaw, there are main two airports which are Warsaw Modlin Airport and Warsaw Chopin Airport. Warsaw Modlin Airport is basically in the suburbs which means that you have to buy another ticket to Modlin station by train first. Then, you have to take bus from the station to the airport. You might wanna ask why I would take flight from there. This is because it is very cheap. Take me as an example. I only spend 16 euro buying the two-way ticket from Warsaw to Sweden. Though the place I landed in Sweden isn't so great. Besides, it flies to London, Edinburgh and Rome, too.
