The Zotter Chocolate Factory is located in Graz, Austria. It was established by Mr. Josef Zotter, who claimed himself as a chocolatier, organic farmer and square peg. Dated back to 1987, Mr. Zotter and his wife opened up the Zotter confectionary shop in Graz. Some of the unusual creations such as "hemp slice," "the funny pie," and "scarlet runner bean roll with coriander" are regionally popular among locals. He expands the business and also more versions of art in chocolate are offered.



The **bean-to-bar** production has been the heart of Zotter chocolate since 2007. The company invests a huge amount of money to process chocolate directly from the cocoa bean onwards. Many new chocolates are created due to the insourcing instead of outsourcing. There are almost a hundred types of chocolate you could choose excluding the customized chocolate and most of them are so creative that you couldn't find them elsewhere.

The **Choco Shop Theatre** offers a unique experience to customers. Visitors can observe the production live and try it both the intermediate products and the finished bars right away at various tasting stations.





The **Zotter Edible Zoo** is an open-air adventure farming. Visitors can experience domestic animal breeds and varieties of regional fruit and vegetables. They can order organic meals, directly from the pastures and gardens.
