Exchange Study Scholarship Application Announcement

To encourage students to study abroad and enhance their international competitiveness through academic and multicultural exchanges, the College of Commerce at National Chengchi University established the "Amundi International Exchange Scholarship" in 2021 with the support of the **Amundi Wealth Management Innovation Research Center.** Interested applicants should complete <u>the online registration (Deadline : October 16th</u>

<u>12:00 at noon time)</u>: and submit the paper documents by <u>October 16th 17:00</u> (Room 607, Yi-Xian Building). Late submissions will not be accepted.

I . [Eligible Recipients]

Overseas Study Scholarships: Bachelor's and Master's degree students currently enrolled at this institution participating in the 2025 Spring Exchange Program or short-term study programs recommended by this institution (excluding double major students, minor students, and inservice students) as well as students pursuing dual degrees.

Ⅱ . [Qualification Requirements]

To apply for the "Overseas Study Scholarship", applicants must meet the following conditions:

1. Excellent academic performance in school. Bachelor's degree students should have a ranking within the top 30% among the classe ; master's degree students should have an overall semester average of 85 points (inclusive).

2. English proficiency: Applicants must meet the English proficiency standards and related regulations outlined in the "學生赴國外進修計畫補助要點" of our institution. If the language of instruction at the study destination is not English, applicants should comply with the relevant rules of the host school/institution.

3. Outstanding achievements : Applicants should have at least one of the following specific accomplishments:

(1) Demonstrated dedication to learning and research with outstanding performance.

- (2) Active participation in public affairs at the school/college/department level with notable contributions.
- (3) Participation in national or international competitions with excellent results.
- (4) Holding key leadership positions in their class or student organizations and demonstrating exceptional leadership skills.

(5) Engaging in charitable activities and having a record of outstanding volunteer service.

(6) Any other exceptional achievements that serve as role models.

- (1) Resume/CV (within 2 pages)
- (2) Official Chinese transcript
- (3) Proof of undergraduate ranking (not required for master's students)
- (4) Valid English proficiency certificate (issued within the last two years)
- (5) Study plan (within 2 pages)
- (6) Supporting documentation for outstanding achievements
- (7) Other documents that may enhance the application review (such as personal/family financial statements, etc.)
- (8) Personal data collection consent form.

 - Online Application Deadline : October 16th 12:00 at noon.
 - Print the application form: After completing the online registration, you will receive a system notification to print out the

application form. It must be signed by your department supervisor and submitted to the Office of International Affairs (Room 607, Yi-Xian Building) by **October 16th 17:00**.

Required Written Documents: (1) <u>Application form:</u> you need to <u>affix a photo</u>, <u>write an address</u>, <u>sign it</u>, and <u>check the required supporting documents (which must</u> <u>match the uploaded documents). It should be signed by your</u> <u>department supervisor.</u>

(2) **Official transcript in Chinese with full academic records.**

(3) <u>Ranking certificate (master's students are exempted from this</u> <u>requirement)</u>.

 Submission Time and Location: Documents must be submitted to Room 607, 6th floor, Yi-Xian Building, Office of International Exchange program (Jane Yang) before 5:00 PM on October 16th 2024. Incomplete or late applications will not be accepted.

- (2) The supporting information for outstanding achievements must match the information provided and include valid proof (clearly indicate the year, month, day, activity name, and position held in accordance with the order of information provided, etc).
