

- > Accommodation: ESSCA offers Studapart services to search for accommodations with easy access to the campus.
- > Health Insurance (compulsory): European students must provide a copy of their EU health card. Non-EU students must provide an international health insurance.
- Visa: Non-European students will need to apply for a visa on Visa application process | France-Visas.gouv.fr. ESSCA will send students an official invitation letter to apply for a visa

Course Syllabus: online Syllabus

ECTS requirement per semester: 15 to 30 ects

Language Requirement: For the programmes taught in English, we strongly recommend that non-native English speakers or students not taking their home university degree in English provide a TOEFL score of 550 or equivalent or have an English professor complete the English language certificate, attesting to a minimum of B2 according to the Common European Framework.

For the programmes taught in French, we strongly recommend a B2 French level.
