Academic Framework:

- ✓ Language of Instruction: All courses are conducted entirely in English.
- ✓ **Credit System:** 1 credit = 8×90 -minute sessions (12 classroom hours).
- ✓ **Grading System:** Grades are awarded on a scale from A (4.00) to F (0.00).
- ✓ Cross-Registration System: Students are free to take courses from both the Graduate School of International Management (GSIM) and the Graduate School of International Relations (GSIR).
- ✓ Course Offerings: A wide range of courses is available in Finance, Marketing, Management, Data Analytics, Sustainability, Innovation and Entrepreneurship, Digital Technology and Operations and Japanese-Style Management.
- ✓ **Japanese Language Courses:** Variable credits are awarded according to proficiency level, with courses offered from beginner to advanced.

- Latest official academic record (transcript at your home institution)

Full Support from Day One - Housing, Visa, and Beyond

Housing and Internet Connection:

IUJ guarantees **on-campus housing** for all exchange students in one of its three dormitories (SD1–3), each just a short walk from classrooms and campus facilities. Every room is fully equipped with free high-speed internet (wired and wireless), creating a convenient and supportive living environment from the very first day. More info: http://www.iuj.ac.jp/cs/.

Estimated Monthly Living Expenses:

- Dormitory fee: Up to JPY 39,000/month
 *10,000 JPY of a maintenance fee at check-in
- Meals: JPY 30,000–40,000/month
- Books and Case Materials: JPY 10,000 /term
- Miscellaneous: JPY 30,000/month -

Visa Support:

To support your entry to Japan, IUJ will apply for your **Certificate of Eligibility (CoE)** on your behalf and send it to you upon issuance. With this document, you can apply for a **Student Visa** at the Japanese embassy or consulate in your country. Full visa assistance is provided throughout the process. Health Insurance:

Enrollment in Japan's National Health Insurance (NHI) is mandatory for those who obtain a Student Visa. With NHI, students pay only **30% of medical costs** at clinics or hospitals. The premium is about 5,000 yen per term. However, as NHI does not cover car accident injuries, students are strongly advised to obtain additional travel insurance before arrival.
